Express Access

Forget about buttons

1. Click in the middle of opening page
2. The next page lists anything new in the last month, or more
e.g. just click on Newsletter, new Photos, or whatever
That's it.

Unlike many other web sites, you don't have to click all over the whole web site on EVERY visit just to find out what's new.

The ONE click above will list ANYTHING that's new on a single page, and the second click will take you there! Is that easy, or what.?

Getting Around More.

The web page and buttons to the left follow a new "Clean Look"

Mousing over them will reveal where they go.

Mousing over the middle shows you how hot the middle is.

Clicking the Banner HOG badge, takes you back to opening page.

A complete **Sitemap** can be found in the bottom right of EVERY page page, just above the copyright. That map shows what you can expect to find on this web site, and how it hangs together.

The blue exit lines you see out of the central ring, are the buttons.

The Explorer

At some point, take the time to check out all the photos, links, buttons and maybe even the fun page. That dart board even have sound when the dart hits the board. There are also links to some very useful other web sites the ones you MUST visit are of course these on Rider Safety, which comes off the Ride page.

Newsletter.

The Latest Newsletter is available allways on the hot page (see Express Access above). For any of the previous two month newsletters, follow the link underneath the Latest newsletter.

For older Newsletters than that, email the webmaster.

Photos

Photos are optimised to display on a computer screen.

All the megapixels from the Camera world are useless on a computer screen, it only has room for so many dots.

So emailing and transporting these megabyte photos on the internet is totally redundant. The pixels are dropped to 80%, just showing you 20%. So to save you long waiting times, redundant pixels are removed in optimisation before being posted on the web site.

Should you however want to PRINT a photo to paper you need ALL the

pixels you can get. Printers are a different technology altogether, they can use most of all those pixels! Email the webmaster if you want a high resolution picture of something.

Small photos (Thumbnails) you can generally click on to see a larger size photo.

Slideshows use www.flickr.com facilities, so just start it, let it run for 3-4 minutes then start from picture 1 using the bottom line thumbnail pictures and you get a smooth and fast transition.

General Tips.

By pressing F11 (a key on your top right keyboard) you can toggle to see more and hide unnecessary browser buttons. Try it.
