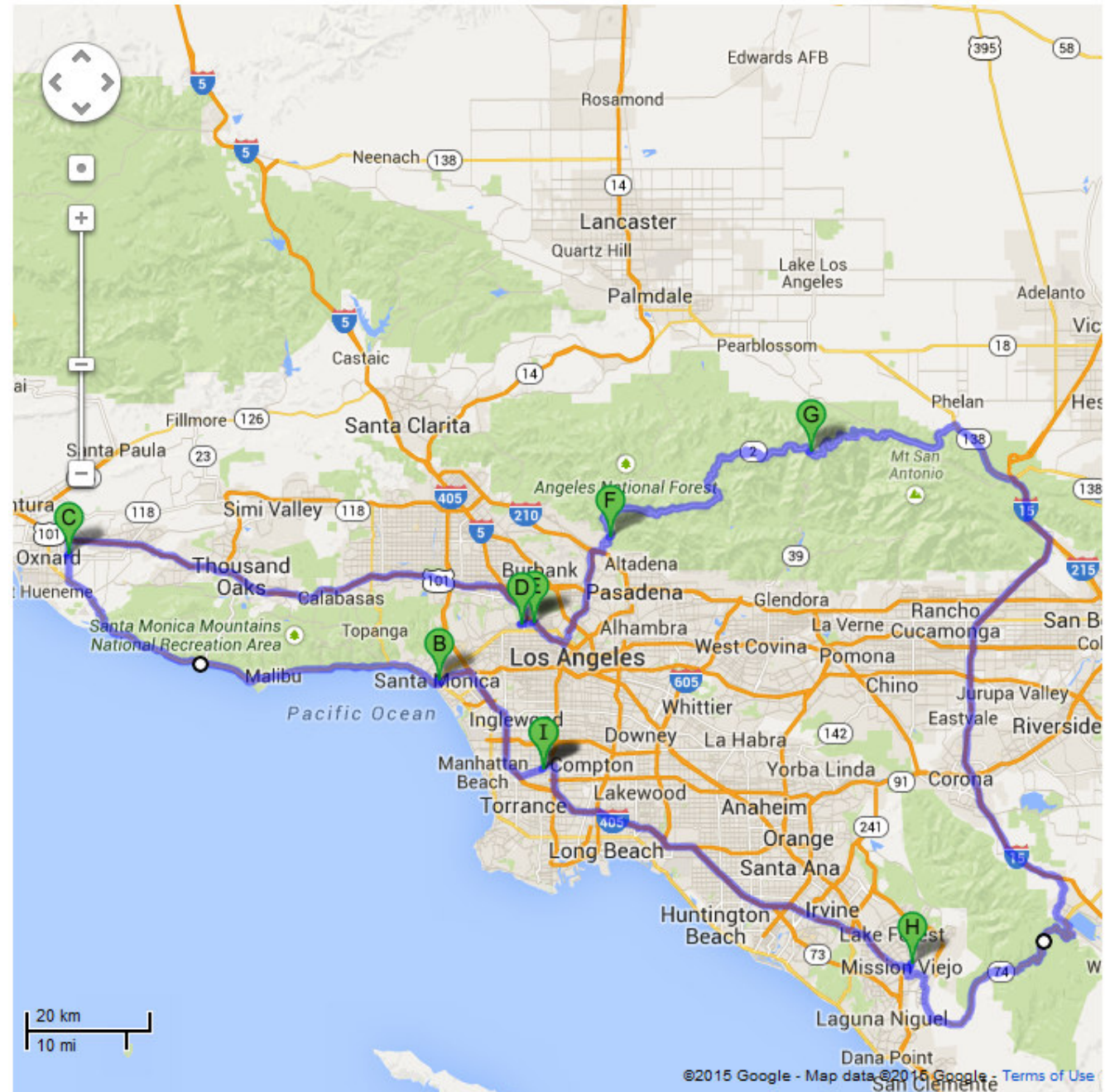

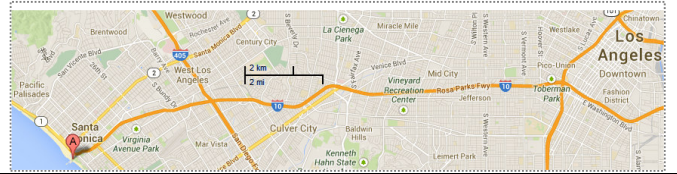

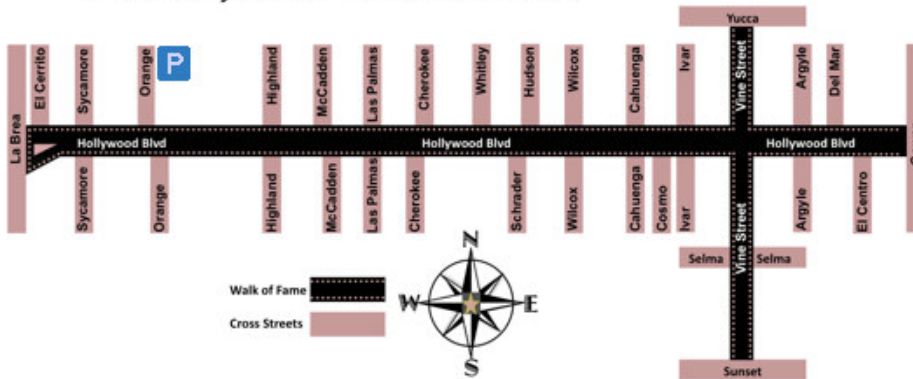

More than 2,400 stars have been immortalized. 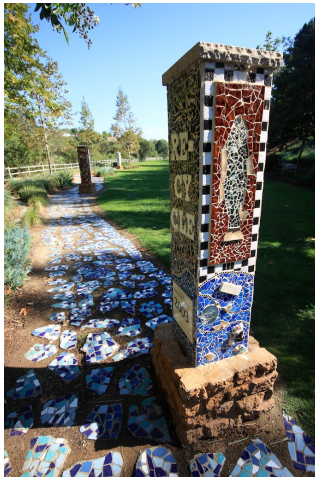
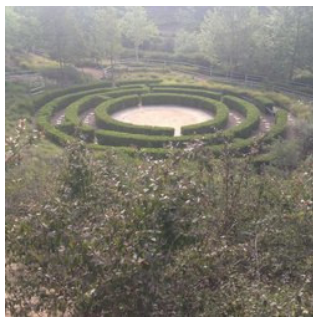

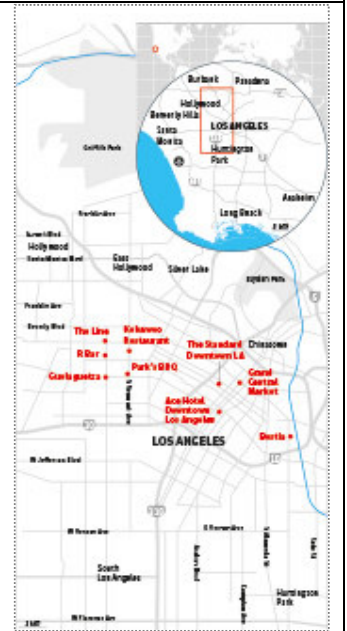

Ride the crest of the Santa Monica Mountains along the curves of Mulholland Drive for spectacular views, day or night. On one side is the San Fernando Valley; on the other side lies Hollywood. On a clear day, you can see as far as the Pacific Ocean.

The city that sprawls from the ocean through valleys to mountain foothills is really a vast amalgamation of much smaller towns, including West Hollywood, Burbank, and Beverly Hills—home to the stars. Universal Studios and Warner Bros. offer tours of the sets and lots where feature films and television shows are made. High culture is on view at the imposing Getty Center. 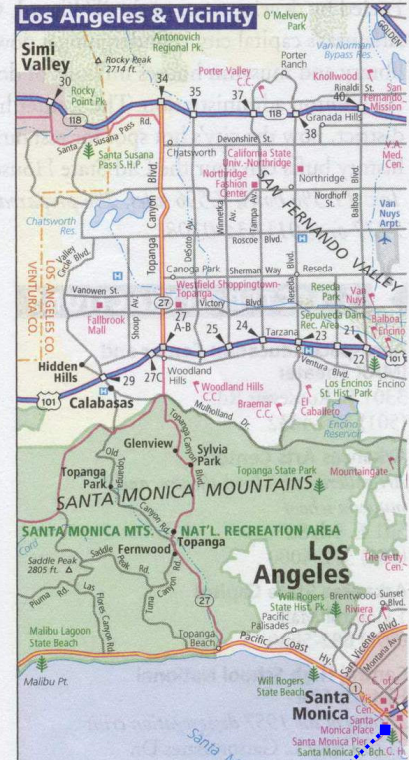
