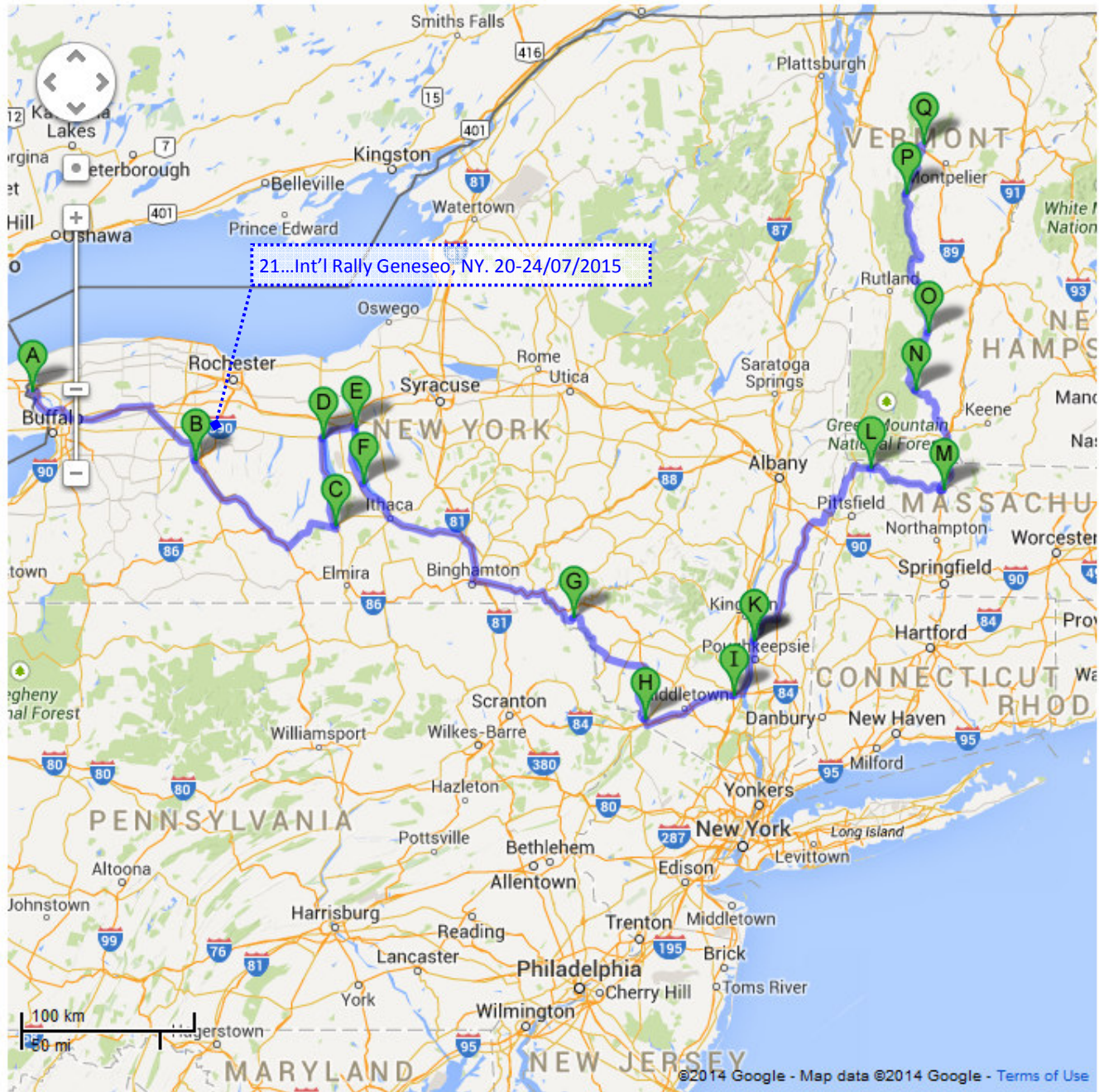

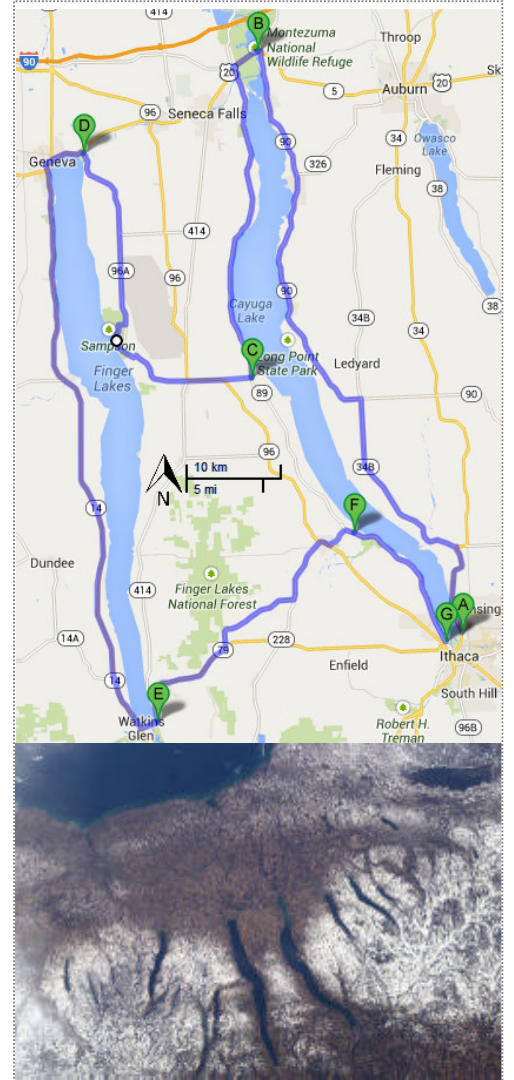

Finger Lakes Region -- New York. - making a loop starting and ending in Ithaca. **N 42.451835°, W 76.515198°** is the start and finish point for this loop, **152 mi, 245 km, 3:11 hrs**

a chain of lakes in central New York State -- shaped, unsurprisingly, like fingers. The chain consists of 11 lakes: Canandaigua, Keuka, Seneca, Cayuga, Skaneateles, Owasco, Otisco, Honeoye, Canadice, Hemlock and Conesus. Formed by glaciers, the lakes extend from an approximately 75-mile (120-kilometer) long line, from Syracuse to Rochester. The lakeshores are dotted with bucolic farmland, quaint towns and hundreds of wineries. The drive is lovely any time of year, but we recommend an autumn trip to take advantage of the dazzling foliage. The region covers about 9,000 square miles (23,309 square kilometers), so most people choose a specific lake or towns upon which to focus. Travel enthusiasts recommend making a loop starting and ending in Ithaca. This loop is about 175 miles (280 kilometers) long. Give yourself a couple of days to make this trip. Along the way, you'll encounter lovely lakefront homes, farms and wine tastings. The area also features many natural gorges with cascading waterfalls -- a great idea for a day hike.

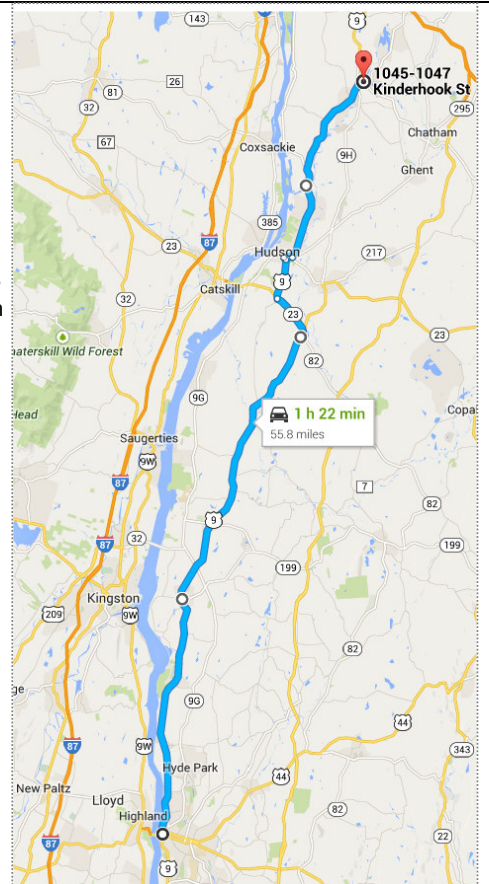


U.S. Route 9. **N 41.707147°, W 73.939686° to N 42.415735°, W 73.685627°, 56 mi, 90 km, 1:22 hrs**

The entire route runs more than 300 miles from Delaware up to the U.S.-Canada border, but this 57-mile lower New York stretch has special appeal when the weather warms. Start in Poughkeepsie and head north toward the town of Valatie, pulling over for fresh produce and organic homemade goods at one of the many local farmers' markets that reopen in late spring. And keep your eyes peeled for Gilded Age estates along the route, such as the Vanderbilt Mansion.

Where to Stop: The historic open-air Hyde Park Farmers' Market, just off Route 9, opens in early June on the grounds of the '50s-era Hyde Park Drive-In Theatre. Further north, in Columbia County, stop at Harvest Spirits Farm Distillery for a bottle of dry apple brandy.

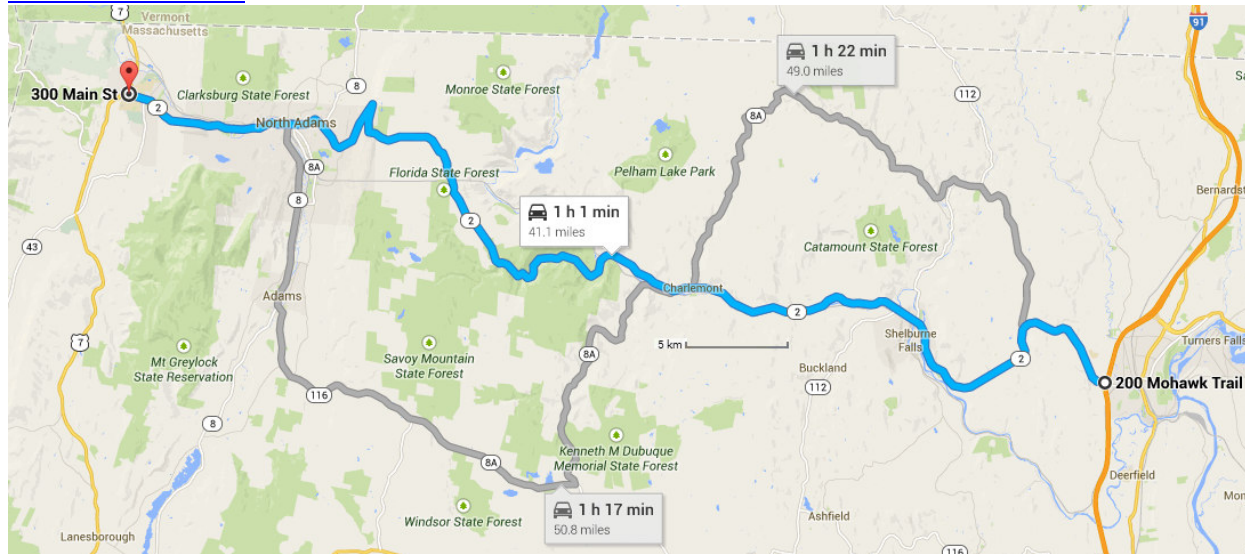
Mohawk Trail, 41 mi, 66 km, 1:01 hrs

Mixing idyllic natural beauty with fine art and roadside Americana, the Mohawk Trail is a classic two-lane highway linking metropolitan Boston with the rural Berkshire countryside. Classic 1920s motor court cabins and the "Big Indian" souvenir shop line a twisting route that ends in the west at the liberal arts enclave of Williamstown.

Where to Stop: Just south of the highway, the Bridge of Flowers in Shelburne Falls is an old trolley bridge reborn as a lush arboretum, high above the Deerfield River. [Attractions/USA-americas-most-scenic-iconic-roads.doc](#)

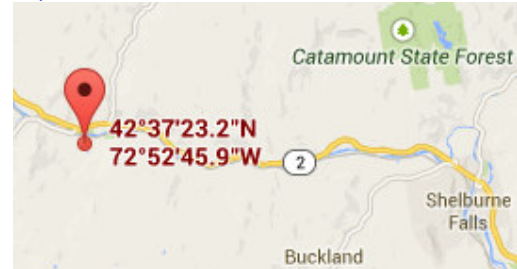

Route 100, From Jacksonville in the S to Ben & Jerry's Ice Cream Factory in the N, **N 42.798629°, W 72.828184° to N 44.35196°, W 72.739744°, 141 mi, 227 km, 3:25 hrs**

Best known for its fall foliage and delicious ice cream, Vermont's lush Green Mountains are also a great place for a drive, thanks to winding country roads like Route 100, which bisects the state from Stowe south to the Massachusetts border. The midsection, between the towns of Waitsfield and Weston, offers the best scenery.

Where to Stop: Gifford Woods State Park. On the Green Mountain crest, west of Woodstock, this patch of primeval forest has been beautifully preserved.
